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The French Quarter Business Women's Network (FQBWN) is a non-profit organization founded in 1989 by a group of local businesswomen whose mission is dedicated to improving the quality of life and business in the French Quarter. The *FQBWN Scholarship for Non-traditional Women Students* provides half the cost of in-state tuition and fees for one year.

An Applicant must:

- ✓ be a registered, non-traditional (23 years of age or above) woman student at the University of New Orleans
- ✓ be an undergraduate who maintains full-time standing (no less than 12 hours) upon receipt of the scholarship
- ✓ maintain at least a cumulative 2.0 G.P.A.
- ✓ demonstrate financial need
- ✓ exhibit academic dedication in the face of hardship.
