APPLICANTS MUST:

- ✓ be a registered female student (25 years of age or above) at the University of New Orleans
- ✓ be an undergraduate working on first bachelor’s degree
- ✓ be an undergraduate who has completed at least 24 hours of college courses
- ✓ be in full-time standing (no less than twelve hours) upon receipt of the scholarship
- ✓ demonstrate financial need
- ✓ have and maintain a 2.5 grade point average or above
- ✓ exhibit academic dedication in the face of hardship.
